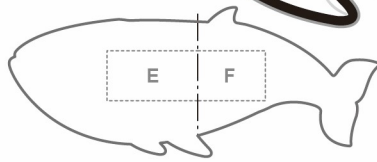
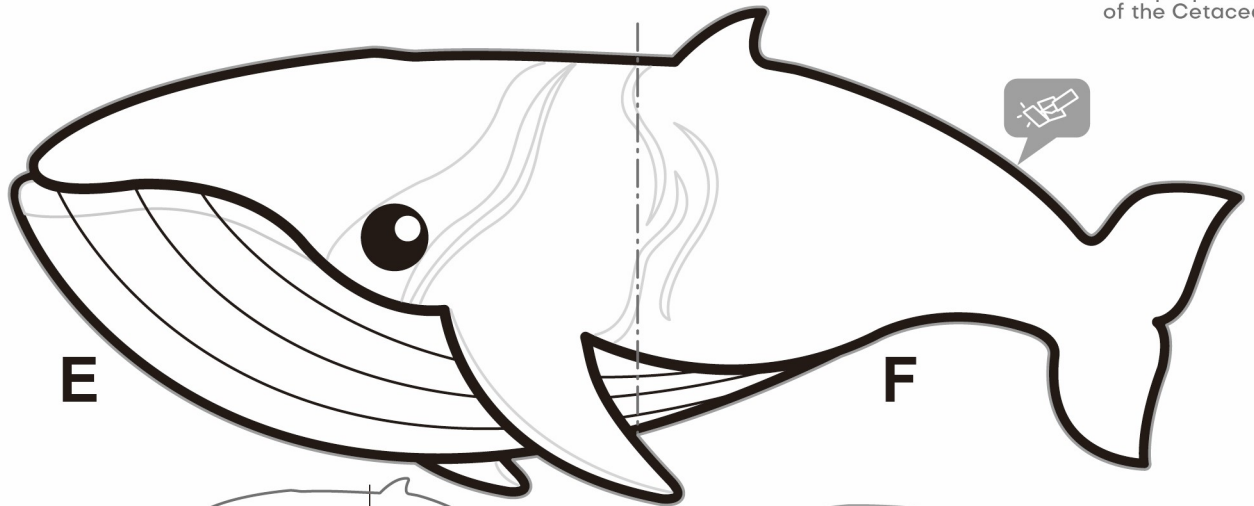


OMURA'S WHALES ^{3D} card

Steps:

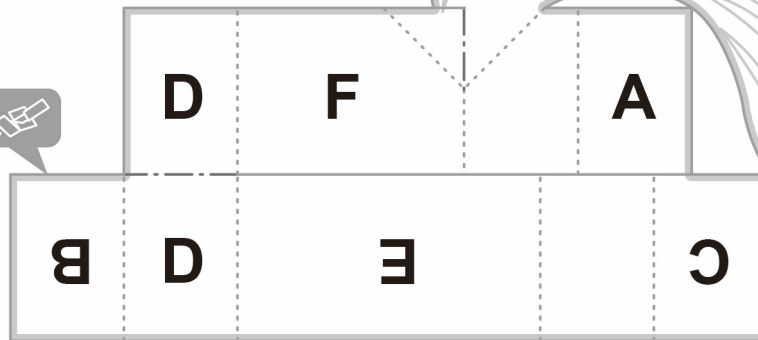
1. Cut the components following the cutting line.

3. Paste the points with the same alphabets together (e.g., A to A, B to B).
